MHA is seeking an experienced Carpenter for a part-time, 20 hour per week position. This is a temporary position for work that will take place between December 1, 2018 and March 31, 2019. Work will consist of rough-in and finish carpentry, drywall hanging and finishing, flooring and ceiling installation and painting. Must be knowledgeable of and be able to work within building code requirements. Up to 20 hours per week. The rate of pay for this position is \$15 per hour.

All positions must successfully complete pre-service training prior to hire. Successful completion of criminal and child abuse background checks are required for all positions. Personal experience with the judicial system may not necessarily eliminate individuals from consideration. Documented eligibility to work in the United States required. MHA IS AN EOE.
