## **PROGRAM FACILITATOR**

*Do you like working in your community? If so, you may be interested in a full-time position at the Mental Health Association organizing members of the mental health and disabilities community to participate in self-empowerment and advocacy activities through participation in Community Support Program activities.*

**Hours:** One Full-time position working up to 40 hours per week in Franklin county and one part-time position working up to 20 hours per week in Fulton County are available.

**Rate of Pay:** \$15 per hour.

**Description:** The Community Support Program (CSP) is a coalition of people with lived experience, family members, behavioral health professionals, and other community members working together to promote wellness, create awareness and encourage positive change to the mental health system.

**Duties:** The CSP Program Facilitator cooperatively guides CSP initiatives and activities, involving stakeholders and developing the leadership capacity of members.

**Skills:** Ability to establish a trusting, respectful relationship with peers is desired. An ability to bring disparate groups of people together to work towards common cause needed. Direct, understandable communication skills are necessary. Good decisions-making skills needed. Mentoring capability extremely helpful.

**Requirements:** An understanding of or lived experience with wellness or disabilities issues a must. Knowledge of system change, community organizing and health care required. Demonstrated facility with computer software, social media and technology.
